At last night's OSCAR General Meeting it was resolved that we would seek an internal review, in the first instance, of your decision in relation to the release of material requested under our RTI application.

As we have not undertaken this process before I am writing to seek your clarification on how we should go about this.

Our basis for requesting a review would relate to the lack of key material being provided without sufficient justification rather than any problem with the process on your part.

Do we simply ask for a review in general terms or do we need to specify reasons for the review request. If so, how granular do these reasons have to be – ie do we instance particular redacted folios?

Your guidance would be appreciated.

Hi Greg

I have now updated the version which appears on the disclosure log.

The 60-page Savills report can be found at folio numbers 67 to 126. Certain information within 11 other pages was previously deferred – which you can find at folio numbers 128, 141, 151, 166, 179, 190, 215, 251, 265, 282 and 291. Most of these 11 are merely citing the Savills report.

A portion of the 289 pages released are scanned images and do not have searchable text, but this is how they would have been presented to the councillors.

Obviously, this is not the case as you had previously advised that a 60-page valuation report dated 22 November 2016 was deferred. Doing a search of the new document only shows 6 instances of reference to the Savills' valuation of 22 November 2016.

Do we need to reconcile the two versions to establish what has now been made available or can you advise the folios that have changed?
