Sunshine Coast Council Integrated Transport Strategy Adopted

I would like to bring to your attention the Sunshine Coast Council Integrated Transport Strategy, adopted by Council on Thursday, 6 December 2018.

The Integrated Transport Strategy (Strategy) outlines Council's policy direction for transport in the region and replaces the Sustainable Transport Strategy. It seeks to respond to the challenges generated by growth, facilitate consideration of new opportunities and help shape a region - and a future - that is healthy, smart and creative.

The Strategy focusses on achieving a connected, smart, integrated, safe and efficient transport system that services and supports a rapidly growing Sunshine Coast.

It was developed with input from the community, key stakeholder feedback and expert analysis, as well as a review of trends and changes occurring across the transport sector. Overall, the feedback was supportive of the Strategy's proposed direction, priorities and actions.

The Strategy will inform future investment decision making on transport related infrastructure and services and in doing so, enable the Sunshine Coast to be better positioned to accommodate the growth forecasts in Shaping SEQ: The South East Queensland Regional Plan.

Council is committed to work with all levels of government and the private sector to ensure there is a 'one network' approach to transport planning, delivery and management of an integrated transport system on the Sunshine Coast.

Thank you for your feedback in helping to shape this significant Council planning document that aims to deliver a better transport future for the region.
