### Second charges estimate notice - your application under the Right to Information Act 2009

Thank you for your email of 27 July 2019 to advise of a narrowed scope for your formal access application under the *Right to Information Act 2009* ("RTI Act"). Accordingly, I am writing to provide the second charges estimate notice.

# **Processing charges**

The charge for time spent by an agency in searching for or retrieving a document, or in making, or doing things related to making a decision on an application for access is \$7.70 for each 15 minutes or part thereof, if the agency spends more than 5 hours doing so.

Based on the time already spent to identify and review the above documents and an estimate of the further time required to provide the decision, I have calculated that the total time required to process your application will be 9.5 hours, for which the charge would be \$292.60. For your assistance I have attached a breakdown of the estimated time. I am satisfied that this is a reasonable estimate, and we will also look to minimise the final charges payable in accordance with the duty in section 58 of the RTI Act.
