Objectives of the Association

General

To protect and enhance the physical environment, heritage and productive economic base of the Blackall Range by influencing land use and town planning regimes, policy, decisions and practices.

Specific

- 1: Preservation of natural vegetation, flora and fauna habitat, water courses and catchments, fauna movement corridors, soils, escarpment and rural scenic quality, rural and village amenity and heritage and cultural elements of the Blackall Range.
- 2: Minimization of detrimental external impacts on the National Parks and State Forests of the district.
- 3: Retention of productive and potentially productive rural zoned land for sustainable primary industry activities (including horticulture, livestock raising, agro-forestry and similar agricultural pursuits).
- 4: Containment and consolidation of the villages and urban settlements of the Range.
- 5: Preservation of the landscape quality and village atmosphere which underpin a sustainable tourist interest of the Range.
- 6: Maintenance of the quality of surface and ground water resources of the Range.
- 7: Promotion of forms of urban and semi urban development of the Range which are environmentally acceptable, and which appropriately meet the diverse social needs of Range residents.
- 8: Encourage the provision of infrastructure and services as and when there is consensus these are required by range residents.
- 9: Discouragement of public and private actions likely to cause pollution, soil instability and degradation and adverse effects on flora and fauna, scenic quality, rural village amenity, cultural heritage and the primary and tourist interests of the Blackall Range.
- 10: Oppose land use and town planning proposals and decisions which are considered contrary to the above objectives.
