Help shape the future of our night skies

Sunshine Coast Council is continuing its journey to preserve our night skies and we would love your input.

We are proposing to establish a Dark Sky Reserve in the hinterland under the International Dark Sky Places Program. The proposed reserve would encompass the Mary River catchment and adjoining State protected areas within the Sunshine Coast Local Government Area and includes (but not limited to) townships such as Maleny, Mapleton, Montville, Witta, Flaxton, Kenilworth and Conondale.

Project update

Since our last community consultation in May 2024, the project remains in Phase 2: Phased Community Engagement and Supporting Technical Documentation. This has included:

- Ongoing stakeholder engagement
- Collection of night sky quality measurements
- Preparation of lighting inventories
- Preparation of a Draft Lighting Management Plan.

What is the Draft Lighting Management Plan?

The Draft Lighting Management Plan is a requirement of Dark Sky International for any Dark Sky Reserve designation. The Draft Plan guides the selection, placement, installation, and operation of new and replacement/retrofitted lighting in the proposed Dark Sky Reserve.
